**SPECTRALITE 2000 SILICONIZED POLYESTER**  
**COATING SYSTEM**  
**FORTY/THIRTY (40/30) YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY**

Rigid Global Buildings, hereinafter referred to as RIGID, is pleased to present you with our Spectralite 2000 Siliconized Polyester Limited Warranty.

1. Our Spectralite 2000 Siliconized Polyester coil coatings, properly applied to HDG steel, G-90, Zinc-Aluminum Alloy steel for commercial or industrial building parts will meet the following standards:
  - a. WILL NOT crack, flake or peel (lose adhesion) to an extent that is apparent on ordinary outdoor visual observation for forty (40) years from date of shipment. Minute fracturing, which may occur in proper fabrication of the building parts, is not a covered Warranty Condition. Failure due to substrate corrosion is not a covered Warranty Condition.
  - b. Within thirty (30) years from the date of installation of the panels:
    - i. WILL NOT chalk in excess of ASTM D-4214 method A number six (6) rating on horizontally installed (roofing) panels and a number eight (8) rating on vertically installed (sidewall) panels, when properly maintained as described herein, and
    - ii. WILL NOT have a color change more than seven (7.0) Hunter delta-E units on horizontally installed (roofing) panels and five (5.0) Hunter delta-E units on vertically installed (sidewall) panels as determined by ASTM method D-2244. Color change shall be measured on an exposed painted surface that has been cleaned of surface soils and chalk, and the corresponding values measured on the original or unexposed painted surface. Color changes may not be uniform on surfaces that are not equally exposed to the sun and elements and RIGID does not warrant that color changes will be uniform.
2. Our LIMITED WARRANTY DOES NOT APPLY to circumstances which we do not control, including:
  - a. Acts of God, external forces, falling objects, fire or other casualty or physical damage.
  - b. Unusual harmful fumes or foreign substances in the atmosphere, standing water, or direct salt spray.
3. RIGID further agrees to replace, repair or repaint, at its option and cost, any effected panels and reserves the right to approve and or negotiate contracts for such painting or replacement. Any repainted or replacement panel supplied as provided herein shall be subject to warranty only for the remainder of the period applicable to the panel originally purchased. The limit of this warranty shall be the cost of repainting, repairing or replacing the effected panels. The obligations under this warranty shall not arise due to failure to remove debris or other accumulation of foreign substances or materials from the panel.
4. THIS WARRANTY IS NON TRANSFERABLE AND NON ASSIGNABLE BEYOND THE ORIGINAL BUILDING OWNER. THERE ARE NO OTHER WARRANTIES EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, WHICH EXTEND BEYOND THE DESCRIPTION AS STATED HEREIN, INCLUDING ANY WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS OF PURPOSE. RIGID SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INDIRECT OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES (SUCH AS DAMAGES TO THE CONTENTS OR FURNISHINGS OF ANY BUILDING) OR ANY LOSS OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER.
5. RIGID warrants only that its panels and trims are free from defects in materials and workmanship on the date of shipment from its plant. RIGID shall determine whether correction of any defect under this warranty shall be by repair or replacement. If RIGID's examination proves the panels and trims to be defective as herein defined, replacement shipment shall be prepaid by RIGID, and return shipment of original material shall be freight collect by the consignee. Title to any replaced material shall pass to RIGID.
6. This warranty does not cover failures resulting from edge corrosion or if a failure is caused by the failure of the metal substrate or conversion coating material or in the application of RIGID's materials, nor does it cover minute fracturing which may occur in proper fabrication of the building parts. This warranty is conditional upon payment in full to RIGID for materials furnished and proper storage of materials prior to installation.
7. All claims filed under the provisions of this warranty must be presented by the Customer to RIGID in writing during the warranty period and not more than thirty (30) days after detection of any apparent defects, delivered by Registered or Certified Mail and referencing RIGID's invoice number and date of shipment.
8. This warranty will apply only to metal which is coated with Spectralite 2000 Siliconized Polyester and used on property located within the continental United States, Alaska and Canada.
9. This warranty shall remain in full force and effect during its term until terminated by giving thirty days written notice. No termination shall affect the rights accrued prior to termination.
10. This is our complete Warranty. It sets out all our obligations regarding the Spectralite 2000 polyester coatings. It is only for the benefit of the original buyer and is non assignable. It cannot be changed by such things as your purchase order forms or any other forms.
